Preparation and Expectations - What you are expected to do!

1. Read and be familiar with the class material/ notes.
2. Be engaged and address the entire group.
3. Try to answer the question succinctly (expressed idea-short and clear).
4. Stay on topic and help the class *investigate* the topic.
5. You must stay within a reasonable time frame (don't monopolize)?

Protocol for Receiving Points [one point for each response].

1. Everyone will remain seated in their assigned seats; this is not public speaking and no one is expected to stand when speaking.
2. Raise your hand to be acknowledged, and contribute your point, answer or question. (The instructor will call on the student with no points, then the lowest points first).
3. Initially, you will be able to freely respond with substantiated opinions to the video prompt, i.e., you cannot simply say, "I agree," or "I think that one guy was rude," etc. (This is a great opportunity to receive points; take advantage of this discussion segment).
4. To receive a 25/25, you must respond in some fashion 5 times over a two day period. This is not unreasonable, and any Junior in high school should be expected to at least answer a question in class. No responses will result in a 0/25.
5. If you are absent from one or two classes, you will be given a makeup assignment. It is to be completed within two days upon your return.

Objective Assessment [one point off for each infraction].

1. The student monopolized the conversation and/or rambled on.
2. The student purposely left the topic.
3. The student interrupted the speaker and/or disrupted the conversation.
4. The student was obviously disengaged from the exercise; head down, texting, etc.
