

Earn the Curve Rubric

All students, regardless of their test grade will have an opportunity to improve their score, but rather than utilizing a curve, you will earn the increase via a quiz.

Here is the procedure:

- You will be permitted to retake a portion of the test (a quiz length assessment) on Friday, October 3rd.
- You will be assessed on a selection of questions drawn exclusively from the online Exam 01-1QTR Review, i.e., no questions will be altered.
- Each question on the quiz will be worth one point. This will not appear as a separate assessment, but will simply be added to your current test score.
- The number of questions/points available will be in proportion to where your score currently falls within the range.
- There will be caps (maximin points) on the improvement of your test score.

- Here's what the distribution looks like.

Current Range	Possible Points/No. of Questions Given	Maximin Score (Cap)
91% - 98%	3	100%
85% - 90%	5	93%
78% - 84%	7	88%
70% - 77%	9	82%
60% - 69%	12	75%
50% - 59%	15	70%
Under 50%	20	65%

- Example: Your test score is a 74% (74/100). I will give you a quiz with 9 questions taken from the online review. If you score a 6/9 on that quiz, your new test score is an 80%; if you score 9/9 on that quiz, your new test score is an 82% (capped).
- Example: Your test score is a 90% (90/100). I will give you a quiz with 5 questions taken from the online review. If you score a 3/5 on that quiz, your new test score is an 93%; if you score 5/5 on that quiz, your new test score is an 93% (capped).
