Read *Sacrament Textbook*, pp. 74-79a (top half page) and answer the following questions.

1. What is the Passover?

It is the great Jewish Feast commemorating the deliverance of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt.

2. How did Jesus break with custom during His last Passover meal? (think what was different between what the 'bread' was called).

He said the unleavened bread was His Body, and that the wine was His Blood.

3. What is the 'Blood of the Covenant.' and what did Jesus' words imply?

It is the sacrificial blood that established the Mosaic covenant between God and Israel.

Jesus was implying that His Blood would establish a New Covenant.

4. What part of the Passover meal did Jesus omit at the Last Supper?

The 'cup of consummation,' or the final cup of wine.

5. How did Jesus refer to the cup of consummation as he prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane?

He asked His Father to 'remove this cup from me,' but said He would drink it if it were His Father's will.

6. How did Jesus request the 'cup of consummation' on the cross?

He said, "I thirst."

7. How did God feed the Israelites when they wandered in the dessert for forty years?
He fed them with manna, Bread from Heaven.

8. How did Jesus feed the vast crowds which cam to hear Him?
He fed them with a miraculous multiplication of loaves and fishes.

9. How did Jesus compare himself to the manna? (think of the effects).
He said He was the Bread of Life who would permanently take away hunger and thirst.

10. List four things that we can do to prepare for receiving the Eucharist. Include one that can be done the very day we receive the Eucharist.
