

Theology III Exam Studying Strategies

1. Three days prior to the exam (approximately 2 hours).
 - Download Exam Review and print it out.
 - From previous quizzes posted on itheo.net, and/or from your class notes, find and record all answers on review.
 - NOTE: Write the answers in the left margin so that you can cover them with a piece of paper or your hand when studying.
 - Pay attention to questions on previous quizzes not listed on review, and for possible questions from unused answers in matching word banks.
 - Listen to the audio review for additional insight into questions not covered or listed on the review. The audio review covered everything that is on the exam.
 - NOTE: At this point, you should now have a completed review for the exam with some expectation of possible additional questions.
2. Two days prior to the exam (approximately 30 minutes).
 - Read through the completed review once.
 - NOTE: Don't cover the answers yet, you're trying to commit the correct answer to memory and make associations between the question, the content and the context.
 - Listen to the audio review once.
3. The day before the exam (approximately 40 minutes).
 - Read through the completed review twice, covering the answers and checking to see if you're correct before you continue.
 - Listen to the audio review once.
4. The day of the exam (approximately 15 minutes).
 - Focus only on questions that you have found difficult. Be at peace and trust in your study efforts.
