Develop questions and points on the following bulleted topics. Pay particular attention to anything you would like to elaborate on, require questions for clarity, or look for ways you can articulate any weakness or strength in the position, topic or specific point.

Be prepared to address:

- A summary the ‘Allegory of the Cave’
 - It’s significance and application to our morality class, and any personal experiences you have to share.
- God’s plan for us and our response
- A summary and contrasting the Priestly Mythos and Enuma Elish.
- Man being made *imago Dei, communio personarum*, and especially authentic freedom compared to autonomy.
- The ‘Fonts of Morality’ and how to apply them to scenarios.
- Other ethical systems (Consequentialism, Proportionalism, Situation Ethics and Deontology). Their principle founders and how to apply them (and identify which is being employed) in ethical scenarios and dilemmas.
 - How would they be critiqued from a Roman Catholic view point?
